

Tour in Tbilisi

Tour route: Bazaleti-Tbilisi-Bazaleti



We will visit the **Cathedral Sameba (XXI)**. It is the largest Orthodox church in the Caucasus, which combines some elements of ancient and modern Georgian architecture. Then, will visit the temple **Metekhi (V-XIII centuries)**. Which wears a name of Virgin Mary located on a high cliff, hanging over the bank of the river **Mtkvari**. From the viewing platform of the church, offers perhaps the most scenic view of Old Tbilisi.

Then visit **Abanotubani (quarter baths)**, where the flowing hot sulfur water, which is associated with the name of the capital and the history of the city. After visiting the temple Abanotubani will visit the **Muslim Mosque (XIX)** After that we go up the hill to the fortress **Narikala (IV)** which is considered the soul of Tbilisi. The whole city is in front of her in full view. Then we will visit the **Armenian (XIII century), Catholic (XIX)** and Zoroastrian temple (Ateshgah ve), and a **Jewish synagogue, Temple (XX)**. After visiting the temples walk down the street **Shardeni**, where the most luxurious in the city of restaurants, bars, casinos and nightclubs.
